**After School Rehearsals will take place for *The Bully Plays* and our Theatre for Young Audiences production. Dates will be communicated and given in the class.**

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**Required Live Theatre Component:** You are required to attend two live theatre productions per semester through Free State Theatre and write a critique. A critique guide and rubric will be provided. These two productions are: *Black Box Theatre Festival* and *All Shook Up*. Any student who cannot purchase a ticket may see the performance for free with permission from Mr. Percival. If you cannot attend a performance, please look at extra credit. Students may see the show for free with permission from Mr. Percival. Please let him know if you cannot afford the student discount.

### Grading Criteria

Small assignments - 100 points

Medium assignments - 300 points

Large assignments - 500 points

Huge assignments - 1000 points

I do not do weighted grades. Earned points will be divided by total points at the end of the semester.

**Absent/Late Work Policy:** Late assignments can be turned in. However, there will be a 10% deduction per day. After 5 days, you may receive up to 50% of the original point value. Missed days in the shop must be made up either on Work Nights or Saturday Work Days.

### FOOD & DRINK POLICY

No food, drink, or gum is allowed in any of the following spaces:

- Stage/Auditorium
- Theatre Classroom/Black Box
- Theatre Scene Shop

Water in a closed container is allowed.

**Bathroom Policy:** During instructional and performance time, the restroom may not be used unless it is a medical emergency with a written note from a nurse and/or doctor. Wait until work time or downtime to use the restroom.

**Extra Credit:** A student may earn extra bonus points for attending any **theatrical** performance at Free State, theatrical video, or in the community during the semester. A student who participates in such a production is eligible for additional bonus points. These may be professional or amateur productions. To receive credit one must provide a written and verbal critique of the production for the class and supply a ticket stub or program of the event. Extra credit will not apply to the two performances required each year.
